This matter is before the Court on Plaintiffs Lisa Rouse's, Juston Rouse's, Jenna Drouin's, Nicholas Drouin's, Kendra Graybeal's, Nichole Edwards's, Lucas Edwards's,

Robert Calamita's, Gina Calamita's, Nicole Robb's, Dave Robb's, Clay Whitenack's, Andrea Lea Hill Whitenack's, Brian Andree's, Alexandra Andree's, Kyle Witzcak's, Brittany Witzcak's, May Jane Gougar's, Chris Lorbecki's, and Kristina De Broux's (together, Plaintiffs) Unopposed Motion for Approval of Class Action Notice Plan. (Doc. No. 654.)

Based on all of the files, records, and proceedings, the Court concludes that the proposed Notice Plan satisfies the requirements of Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(c)(2), and, therefore, the GRANTS the motion. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Notice Plan outlined in the Declaration of Cameron R. Azari, Esq. (Doc. No. 657) is APPROVED.
2. The Court appoints Equip Class Action & Claims Solutions, Inc. as Class Administrator; and
3. The Court adopts the schedule set forth below:

Notice Period	Six weeks, beginning on the Notice Date
Defendants' first payment to QSF for Notice Plan costs	Within 30 days of the entry of the Notice Plan, in an amount to be determined by Equip
Deadline for Class Member Opt-Out	30 days after end of Notice Period
Deadline for Class Member Objections to Settlement (Objection Deadline)	30 days after end of Notice Period
Plaintiffs to file Motion for Attorneys' Fees, Costs, and Incentive Awards	No later than 7 days after the Objection Deadline

Event	Deadline/Date
Plaintiffs to file Motion for Final Approval, Proof of Notice and Response to Objections	No later than 7 days after the Objection Deadline
Final Approval and Fairness Hearing	September 29, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.
Defendants' second payment to QSF for attorneys' fees, service awards, and administration costs	Within 30 days of the Final Approval Order
Deadline for Class Members to submit claims forms	9 months after Notice Date
Defendants' third and final payment to QSF for distribution of settlement proceeds to class members with valid claims submissions	30 days after the deadline for claims expires and final payment amount is determined by Epiq, or 30 days after the Final Approval Order becomes final, whichever is later
